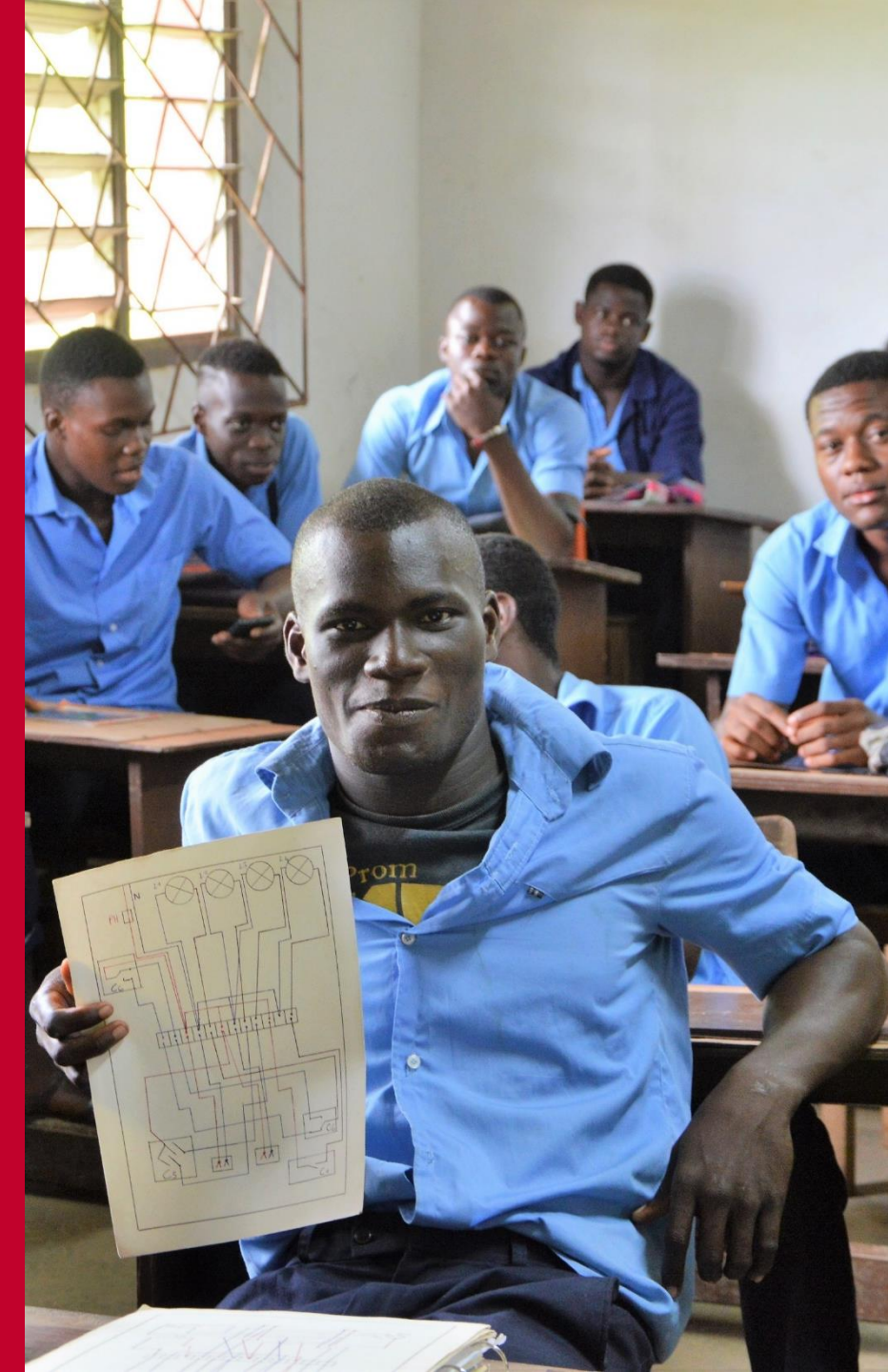


# Our mission?
